PHEN Kicks Off Houston, Texas Prostate Cancer Disparity Rally

Quincy, MA, October 15, 2023 — PHEN kicks off its Houston, Texas Prostate Cancer Disparity Rally to run from October 15th through November 9th. This follows, and continues, the prostate cancer awareness campaign that PHEN conducted in Dallas, Texas at the Cotton Bowl during the State Fair Classic football game between HBCUs Prairie View A&M and Grambling on September 30th. The Houston Rally will consist of radio (KMJQ, KROI, and KTSU) and social media prostate cancer awareness campaigns culminating with a virtual Town Hall meeting.

Congresswoman Sheila Jackson Lee (TX-D18) and Rev. Dr. Frederick Haynes III (Senior Pastor at Friendship-West Baptist Church in Dallas and Rainbow Push Coalition CEO) are headline voices for the Houston rally. Both recorded prostate cancer awareness messages for PHEN's State Fair Classic campaign in Dallas. They will be joined as rally participants by Rev. Dr. Timothy Sloan, Senior Pastor at The Luke Church, Dr. Curtis A. Pettaway from MD Anderson Cancer Center, and Mr. Dewayne Charleston, a Houston prostate cancer survivor. PHEN's President Mr. Thomas Farrington, Director of Community Partnership Rev. Adrian Backus, and Director of Clinical Trials and Patient Education Dr. Keith Crawford will all be active participants in the Houston rally.

The virtual Town Hall Meeting on November 8th will bring additional local leaders together to discuss community needs, ongoing awareness efforts with educational symposiums, and free prostate cancer early detection screening.

PHEN's Prostate Cancer Disparity Rallies raise public awareness and knowledge as well as mobilize communities to come together with PHEN in efforts to eliminate the prostate cancer racial disparity. Prostate cancer is the leading cause of cancer among Black men who die at a rate more than two times higher than all other men from this disease.
